#### A. GRAMMAR

##### I. Multi-word verbs (Cụm động từ)

- **Cụm động từ (multi-word verbs hay phrasal verbs)** là một động từ kết hợp với một trạng từ (adverb) hoặc một giới từ (preposition), hoặc đôi khi cả hai, để tạo thành một động từ mới thường có nghĩa đặc biệt.
- Một số cụm động từ thường dùng:

Multi-word verb	Meaning	Multi-word verb	Meaning
<b>bring up</b>	nuôi nấng; dạy dỗ	<b>look after</b>	chăm sóc; trông nom
<b>come across</b>	tình cờ gặp; tình cờ tìm thấy	<b>grow up</b>	lớn lên; trưởng thành

<b>go on</b>	tiếp tục	<b>throw away/ out</b>	ném đi; vứt đi

<b>turn on/ off</b>	bật/ tắt (đèn, máy móc, động cơ, bếp gas, vòi nước...)	<b>catch up/ catch up with</b>	bắt kịp; theo kịp
<b>turn up/ down</b>	tăng/ giảm (âm lượng, nhiệt độ, áp suất.v.v. của các thiết bị, máy móc)	<b>take off</b>	(máy bay) cất cánh; cởi (quần áo, giày, mũ...)
<b>type in</b>	nhập dữ liệu vào máy tính	<b>carry out</b>	tiến hành; thực hiện
<b>zoom in/ out</b>	phóng to/ thu nhỏ	<b>look down on</b>	coi thường

##### II. Indefinite & quantifying pronouns (Đại từ bất định & Đại từ chỉ số lượng)

###### 1. Indefinite pronouns (Đại từ bất định)

- Là những đại từ dùng để nói về **người hoặc vật không xác định rõ ràng**, mang nghĩa chung chung.
- Được dùng với **động từ số ít (singular verb)**.
- Một số ví dụ về đại từ bất định:

Đại từ	Ý nghĩa	Ví dụ
<b>everyone/everybody/everything</b>	mọi người/mọi thứ	Everyone <b>has</b> a mobile phone.
<b>no one/nobody/nothing</b>	không ai/không có thứ gì	Nobody <b>knows</b> the answer.
<b>hardly anyone/hardly anybody/hardly anything</b>	hầu như không ai/ hầu như không có thứ gì	Hardly anyone <b>speaks</b> French here.

###### 2. Quantifying pronouns (Đại từ chỉ số lượng)

- Là đại từ dùng để **chỉ số lượng người hoặc vật**, thường dùng khi số lượng **không được xác định chính xác**.
- Đại từ chỉ số lượng có thể đứng độc lập, không có danh từ đằng sau.
- Được dùng với **động từ số nhiều (plural verb)**.
- Một số ví dụ về đại từ chỉ số lượng:

Đại từ	Ý nghĩa	Ví dụ
<b>all</b>	tất cả	All <b>are</b> welcome.
<b>almost all</b>	hầu hết tất cả	Almost all <b>have finished</b> already.
<b>a lot</b>	rất nhiều	A lot <b>have complained</b> .
<b>quite a few</b>	khá nhiều	Quite a few <b>have joined</b> .
<b>half</b>	một nửa	Half <b>are</b> interested.

<b>several</b>	vài, một số	Several <b>have left</b> already.
<b>a few</b>	một vài	A few <b>were missing</b> yesterday.
<b>not (that) many</b>	không nhiều (lắm)	Not many <b>know</b> the answer.
<b>very few</b>	rất ít	Very few <b>have passed</b> the exam.
