We use the Present Continuous for actions happening right **now**.

POSITIVE	NEGATIVE	QUESTION
I am playing.	I am not playing.	Am I playing?
He / She / It is playing.	He / She / It is not playing.	Is he / she / it playing?
We / You / They are playing.	We / You / They are not playing.	Are we / you / they playing?
