Cách dùng	Công thức	Ví dụ
Dùng để nói về sự yêu thích hoặc sự ưu tiên của ai đó với một cái gì đó.	S + like(s) + noun/pronoun	I like coffee. She likes reading books.
Dùng để so sánh sự giống nhau giữa người, vật, hoặc sự việc.	S + V + like(s) + noun/pronoun	She looks like her mother. This cake tastes like chocolate.

❖ **Note:** S = subject: chủ ngữ; V = verb: động từ; noun: danh từ; pronoun = đại từ.






