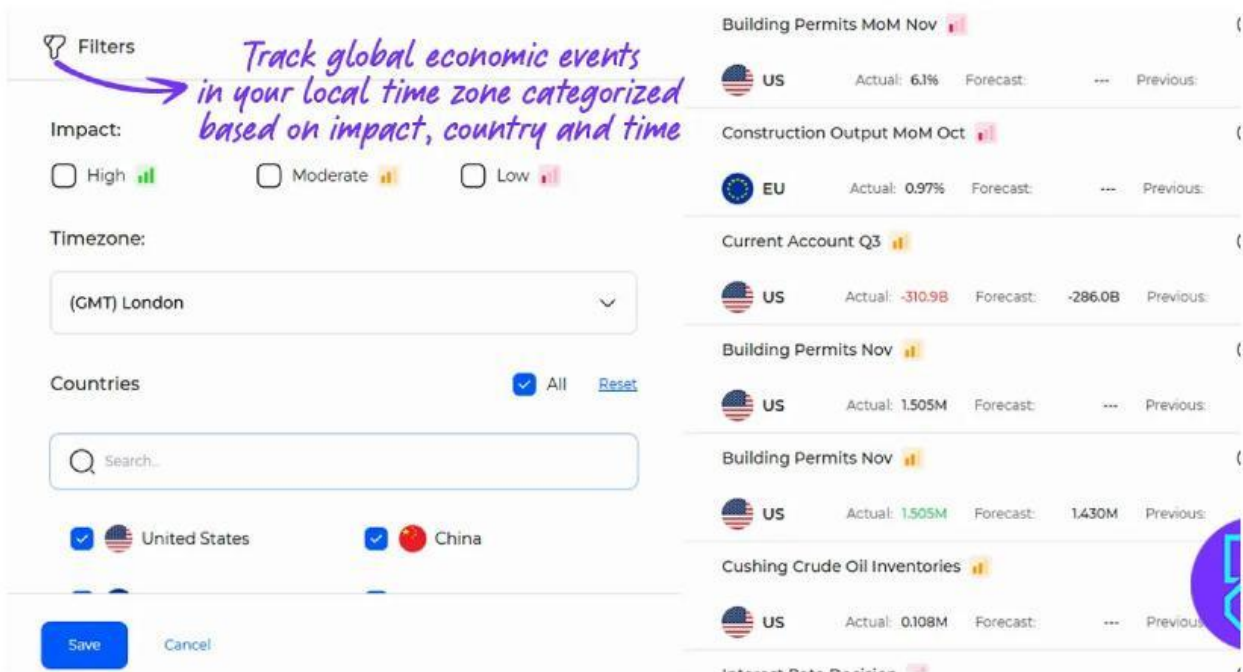

How to Install the TradingFinder Economic Calendar Extension?

TF Economic Calendar Extension is available on popular browsers like **Google Chrome** and **Microsoft Edge** for Windows and Mac devices. **Android** and **iOS** users can also access it through the **Kiwi Browser**. To install the extension in **under 3 minutes**, follow these steps:

1. Visit your browser's respected extension store (e.g., Chrome Web Store);
2. Search for "**TradingFinder Economic Calendar**";
3. Select the extension and click "Add to Chrome";
4. Approve the required permissions to begin downloading and installation.

Once installed, **pin the extension** from the browser toolbar for easy access. Beside extension, you can use **Forex Economic Calendar** on-site Tool in TradingFinder website.
