A. EXTRA GRAMMAR - “Would like” for invitations (“Would like” để mời/đề nghị)

- **Cách dùng:** “Would like” có cùng nghĩa với “want”; dùng để thể hiện lời mời hoặc đề nghị nhưng theo một cách lịch sự hơn “want”.
- **Cấu trúc:** Would you like to + V-inf?
- **Ví dụ:**

Câu hỏi	Chấp nhận đề nghị	Từ chối đề nghị
Would you like to bake a cake?	Yes, I'd love to. Yes, please. Sure, please.	I'd love to but I can't... I'm sorry but I can't... No, thanks.

❖ Note: I'd = I would; V-inf: động từ nguyên mẫu


