## Symbols of Justice

**symbol** = a thing or picture used to show an idea

**justice** = treating people fairly; giving people the consequences they deserve for their actions

For 500 years or more, we have used a blindfolded (can't see) woman holding a sword and balance scales to symbolize justice.
