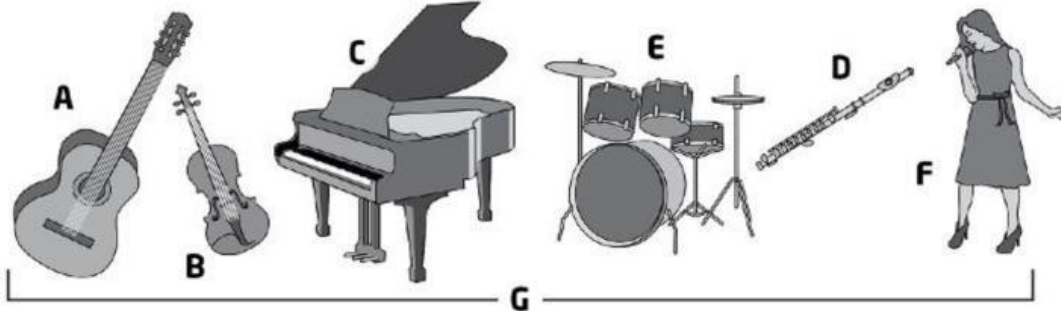

There are different kinds of instruments. The flute is a wind instrument. Like the sound of the wind, the music comes from moving air. Some wind instruments have holes for fingers. Others have buttons to press. Another way to make music is with strings. The violin is a string instrument. When you slide a finger over a string, or when you pluck it, it makes music. You can also make music by hitting or shaking something that makes a sound. That's because most things make a sound when you hit them. An empty space inside the instrument makes the sound louder. These are percussion instruments. The drum is a percussion instrument.

All About Electric Guitars

If you like rock music, you probably like the sound of electric guitars. Electric guitars were an important instrument in bands that played dance music in the 1930s. When lots of people danced in one place, the instruments needed to be loud so everyone could hear them. Inventors discovered that adding an electric current to a wooden guitar made the sound of the guitar louder. Some musicians didn't like the sound of electric guitars, but many jazz musicians loved playing the new instrument. This new music was called rock music. As more audiences heard rock music with electric guitars, they started to like the sound. By the 1950s, bands with electric guitars were playing big concerts all around the world. Technology made it easier to make louder electric guitars, and to make electric guitars in any color and in different shapes. Inventors also made electric guitars with different numbers of strings, and guitars that could make many different sounds.
