We use the Future Simple for: future actions which may or may not happen, for predictions about the future, for promises or on-the-spot decisions.

POSITIVE	NEGATIVE	QUESTION
I <b>will phone</b>	I <b>will not \ won't phone</b>	<b>Will I phone?</b>
<b>He\she\it will phone</b>	<b>He\she\it will not \ won't phone</b>	<b>Will he\she\it phone?</b>
<b>You\we\they will phone</b>	<b>You\we\they will not \ won't phone</b>	<b>Will you\we\they phone?</b>
