Fear Acquisition

Experience

- Negative reaction such as a feeling of 31 causes fear
- Ex: Childhood fear of 32

Observation

- People recognise a 33 by observing others
- Infants watch parents to determine the 34 reaction
- Ex: Parent panics, so child is scared of wasp

Instruction

- Involves 35 sharing
- Can also result from 36 instruction
- Ex: Movie about sharks makes people scared to swim

Phobias

- Fear can lead to development of a phobia
- Causes physical 37 like dizziness, nausea, and increased heart rate
- Affects mental well-being
- May result in a high level of 38 anxiety

Exposure Treatment

- People confront fears in a 39 environment
- Graded exposure: Sessions become longer
- Desensitisation: Patient learns relaxation 40
