

Present Continuous with always

You use **always** and a **continuous verb** to talk about things people do a lot. A continuous verb ends in +ing.

Examples:

- He **is always playing** basketball at lunch time.
- The girls **are always coming** late for class.
- I **am always watching** TV instead of doing my homework.
