

I have just visited a place that is incredibly beautiful and unique, with vast craters. The Kelimutu volcano is located 50 km east of Ende in central Flores, accessible via a road that winds through small villages and rice terraces. Since this volcano is part of a national park, the entrance fee is applicable. It is affordable for locals and foreign Indonesian work visa holders, while for international tourist, it is slightly higher (around US\$15).

From parking area, a few hiking trails go up to the summit which features 3 steep-sided craters with actively roiling multi-colored lakes. On a clear day you can see gases bubbling to the surface and a sulfide scum on the surface of the first two lakes. The local lake names are Tiwu Ata Bupu (Lake of Old People - blue), and the other two lakes, Tiwu Ko'o Fai Nuwa Muri (Lake of Young Men and Maidens - bluish-green) and Tiwu Ata Polo ("Villany" Lake - red) separated by a shared crater wall.

The distinctive lake colors are resulted from gas and steam. They vent from the bottom of two crater lakes, releasing CO₂ and H₂S gases from a magma chamber deep beneath the mountain. The colors change yearly due to different chemical reactions involving rainwater, groundwater, volcanic gases, and the presence of iron and manganese. Notably, the colors in each lake change independently, suggesting a unique connection to the underlying magma chamber. Many impressions at Kelimutu await you there!


Prince Philip, Duke of Edinburgh, was Queen Elizabeth II's husband and the father of Charles, who became king in 2022.

Data Encryption

Encryption is a way of scrambling data so that only authorized persons can understand the information. In technical terms, it is the process of changing human-readable plaintext to random text, also known as ciphertext. In simpler terms, encryption takes readable data and modifies it. Therefore, it appears randomly.

Encryption requires the use of a cryptographic key, a set of mathematical values that both the sender and the recipient of an encrypted message agree on. A cryptographic key is a string of characters used within an encryption algorithm for modifying data. Like a physical key, it locks (encrypts) data so that only someone with the right key can unlock (decrypt) it.

Encryption is important in several ways. Encryption ensures that no one can read any data except the intended recipient or the rightful data owner. This prevents hackers, ad networks, internet service providers, and even governments from capturing and reading sensitive or private data. Encryption also helps prevent malicious behavior such as on-path attacks. When data is transmitted across the internet, encryption ensures that what the recipient receives has not been viewed or changed during the transmission.

PowerPoint allows you to add audio to your presentation. For example, you could add background music to one slide, a sound effect to another, and even record your own narration or commentary. You can then edit the audio to customize it for your presentation.

Follow the steps below.

1. Open your PowerPoint application via a laptop or personal computer then open the presentation you want to work on.
2. After that, from the Insert tab, click the Audio drop-down arrow, then select Audio on My PC.
3. Next, locate and select the desired audio file, then click Insert, to add the audio to the slide.
4. If you want to record audio directly into a presentation before you begin, make sure you have a microphone that is compatible with your computer; many computers have built-in microphones or ones that can be plugged in to the computer.
5. From the Insert tab, click the Audio drop-down arrow, then select Record Audio.
6. Type a name for the audio recording if you want.
7. Click the Record button to start recording.
8. When you're finished recording, click the Stop button.
9. To preview your recording, click the Play button.
10. When you're done, click OK. The audio file will be inserted into the slide.
