Sullivan did not talk about the potential response in greater detail to the general public, but the necessary information was passed to Moscow. Sullivan added Russia has been contacted many times to talk over the war in Ukraine, but apparently Putin desires to continue his massive ethnic cleansing in that country and says that the Ukrainian nation must cease to exist.

Dandruff can be diagnosed by white flakes of skin on your scalp, which often becomes itchy. The condition affects up to 3% of world population. Various factors can cause dandruff, for instance, dry skin, dermatitis or bad reaction to hair products. If dandruff on your scalp is not serious, first use a gentle shampoo to reduce oil and the accumulation of skin cells. If a mild shampoo doesn't help, try a medical shampoo for fighting dandruff. Most people tolerate a medical shampoo that is used two to three times a week. Use a normal shampoo on the other days.

Tekst B

What the product is for

Rid Anti-Dandruff Shampoo is used for treating and preventing dandruff. The shampoo has ketoconazole in it, which kills excessive number of Malassezia – yeasts living on the scalp. These yeasts are normally present on the scalp, however, people with dandruff have more Malassezia. The medical shampoo also treats the inflammation caused by dandruff, and relieves scalp redness and itching. This product can be used by adults and adolescents over twelve years old.

How to use the product:

- Use every 3 days for 4 weeks.
- If you still suffer from dandruff after 4 weeks, consult your doctor or pharmacist.
- To keep your scalp clear and to prevent dandruff returning, use Rid Anti-Dandruff Shampoo once every two weeks. If you stop using Rid Anti-Dandruff Shampoo altogether, your symptoms may become a problem again.
- Not for children aged under twelve.

There are many products specifically used to treat dandruff; however, natural remedies are often as effective as medical shampoos, and may be less harmful. Here are some simple home remedies how to get rid of dandruff naturally. When applied as a moisturizer, coconut oil may be very helpful in enhancing skin hydration. Research shows that coconut oil helps treat eczema, a skin condition which can partly cause dandruff. Aloe vera is often added to lotions and cosmetics. It also helps treat conditions such as burns and cold sores when it is applied to the skin. Some reviews point out that the antibacterial properties of the succulent may also relieve dandruff. Stress as such doesn't contribute to dandruff directly, but it may make itching and dryness worse. Long-term high stress levels may weaken your immune system, which means your body will find it harder to fight off infections and skin conditions.

DERMATOLOGIST: A lot of research has been done into it, but the truth is we don't know yet. We do know it's not a hygiene issue. There's a little yeast which naturally lives on our skin, Malassezia. In certain individuals, it can become a little bit too comfortable.

INTERVIEWER: People often complain about dandruff in certain times of the year. What actually triggers it?

DERMATOLOGIST: Stress is certainly a common trigger, and certain medical conditions such as Parkinson's disease.

INTERVIEWER: Is there one thing that people suffering from dandruff absolutely need to know?

DERMATOLOGIST: One of the things to know about this little yeast is that it only grows in oil. That yeast thrives in the oily surfaces of our skin. The oils that you apply to the scalp, styling oils or cosmetic oils, make a nice cosy environment for that yeast. If you shampoo your hair more frequently, you'll cut down on the amount of oil in the scalp and as a result, you'll improve dandruff.
