Grammar

Present Simple – Negative Form

We use **don't** (do not) and **doesn't** (does not) to make negative sentences in the present simple.

► For I, you, we, they, we use **don't**:

- I **don't** like cooking.
- They **don't** play video games.

► For he, she, it, we use **doesn't**:

- She **doesn't** like doing homework.
- He **doesn't** watch TV.

✓ The main verb (like, do, watch, etc.) stays in the **base form** (no “-s”) after **don't/doesn't**.

Present Simple – Interrogative Form

We use **do** and **does** to make **questions** in the present simple.

► For I, you, we, they, we use **do**:

- **Do** you like reading books?
- **Do** they play games?

► **For he, she, it, we use does:**

- **Does** she like watching TV?
- **Does** he clean his room?

✅ The main verb stays in the **base form** (no “-s”) after **do/does**.
