Based on Mark 14: 17-31 and Luke 22: 14-23 (also in Matthew)

1. The meaning of the Lord's Supper

A special meal Jesus shared with His disciples.
It helps us remember Jesus' sacrifice (His death on the cross).
It shows Jesus' love for all people.

2. The Gospels that tell the story of the Lord's Supper

Matthew, Mark, and Luke tell about it.
John does not describe the Lord's Supper in the same way.

3. The importance to follow Jesus' instructions

It shows respect and obedience.
Jesus gave us rules because He loves us.
Following His rules helps us be good followers of Jesus.

4. The meaning of the 'Lord's Supper'

A sacred meal Jesus shared to remember Him.
It is a symbol of Jesus' love and sacrifice.
We do this to stay close to Jesus.
