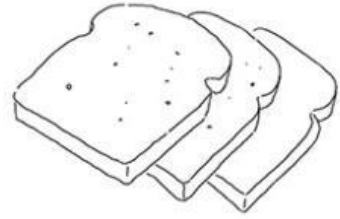

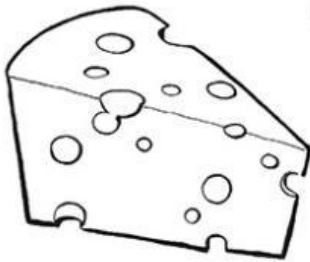
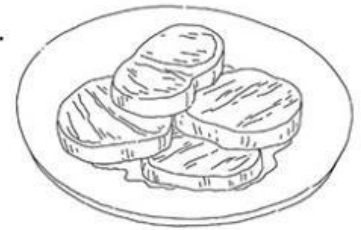


Read the riddles.

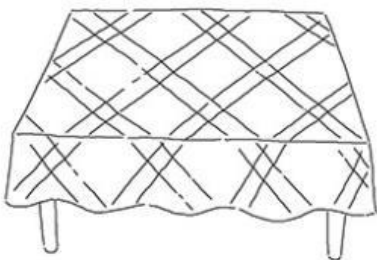
- ① I have fruit in me. I am red.
