👉 *is/are + being + past participle*

- ◆ *A scene **is** being **filmed**.*
- ◆ *The lights **are** being **set up**.*

Passive Past Continuous

👉 *was/were + being + past participle*

- ◆ *The scene **was** being **filmed** yesterday.*
- ◆ *Actors **were** being **interviewed**.*

Passive Future with "Going to"

👉 *is/are going to be + past participle*

- ◆ *A stunt **is** going to be **filmed**.*
- ◆ *The cameras **are** going to be **moved**.*
