Present Perfect – Affirmative

E.g.

1) (I / study / French)

I have studied French.

I've studied French.

2) (She / eat / octopus)

3) (They / go / to Scotland)

4) (He / live / here for three years)

5) (We / be / here for two weeks)

6) (He / drink / too much coffee)

7) (They / write / to the politician)

Present Perfect – Negative

E.g.

1) (We / not / go / to Paris)

We have not gone to Paris.

We haven't gone to Paris.

2) (She / not / see / The Lord of the Rings)

3) (They / not / be / in London for six months)

4) (She / not / make / dinner)

5) (Lucy / not / do / her homework)

6) (She / not / clean / the kitchen)

7) (We / not / find / the book yet)

Present Perfect – Questions

E.g.

1) (They / go / to the USA)?

Have they gone to the USA?

2) (You / read / War and Peace)?

3) (They / live / here as long as we have)?

4) (You / go / to Australia)?

5) (They / take / the exam)?

6) (How long / she / live in London)?

7) (Where / you / be)?
