**A. EXTRA GRAMMAR****1. Comparison adverbs (Trạng từ so sánh)**

- **Định nghĩa:** Trạng từ so sánh dùng để chỉ sự khác biệt giữa hai hành động. Ví dụ như nhanh hơn, chậm hơn, tốt hơn.

Trạng từ so sánh	Cách dùng	Ví dụ
more + adverb+ than	dùng để nói nhiều hơn	He runs more quickly than me.
less + adverb + than	dùng để nói ít hơn	She behaves less nicely than her brother.
as + adverb+ as	dùng để nói sự giống nhau	Tom runs as quickly as Jerry.

2. Linking Words: When, While, As (Liên từ: When, While, As)

Liên từ	Cách dùng	Ví dụ
when (khi)	dùng để nói về thời gian trong quá khứ, hiện tại hoặc tương lai	When I wake up, I eat breakfast.
while (trong khi)	dùng để nói về 2 hành động xảy ra cùng lúc	I read a book while she draws pictures.
as (khi mà)	dùng để chỉ sự việc xảy ra đồng thời hoặc trong lúc làm một hành động nào đó	As I was leaving, she came in.

The two boys have won a lot of prizes for their computer game and it will soon be on sale around the world. Many schools are interested in buying it.






