"some" - plural countable (some bananas); uncountable (some water) - **AFFIRMATIVE (+)**

**BUT**

\***SOME** - **QUESTION** - request (Can I get **some**...?)

- offer (Would you like **some**...?)

"any" - plural countable plural (any bananas); uncountable (any water) **NEGATIVE (-)**:

**INTERROGATIVE (?)**
