

My Haiku Poem



Haiku poems are traditional Japanese poems that are made of three lines. They are typically about nature. The first line must have five syllables, the second line needs seven syllables, and the last line must have five syllables. Hint: A syllable is one unit of sound that usually includes just one vowel (or team). Examples: flow-er (2 syllables), paint-ing (2), dog (1), won-der-ful (3)
