### Use Present Perfect for:

- Life experiences (no specific time)
- Ongoing relevance

- I **have met** Bono.
- She **has travelled** to Dublin.
- I **haven't been** to Mexico.
- She **hasn't seen** him recently.
- **Have** you **been** to China?

### Use Past Simple for:

- Finished time expressions (last year, in 2009, etc.)
- I **met** Bono in 2009.
- She **went** there last year.
- He **didn't meet** his friends yesterday.
- Where **did** you **go** on holidays?
- **Did** you **eat** pizza last week?
