Grammar Explanation

Adjective position and agreement:

- Adjectives in English **go before nouns**:
→ *a big house / an expensive car / a strong man*
- Adjectives **don't change**: no plural forms like in Spanish.
→ *a big car / big cars* (no "bigs")
- **Modifiers**: *quite, very, really* go before adjectives:
 - *It's quite hot today.* (a little)
 - *It's very hot today.* (a lot)
 - *It's really hot today!* (stronger than "very")
