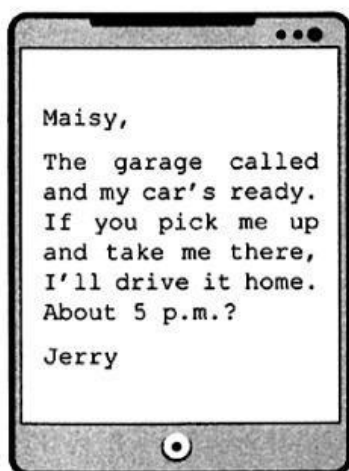

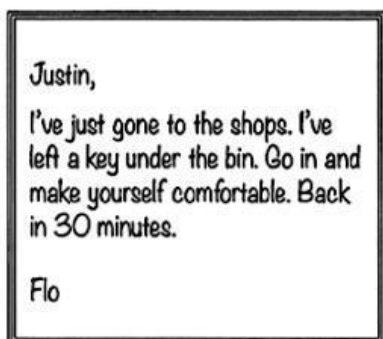

By 1974, a quarter of the forest had already been cut down. In the following year, 1975, four percent of the remaining trees went. 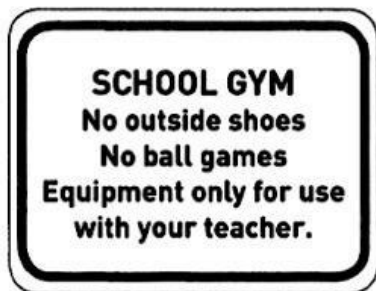

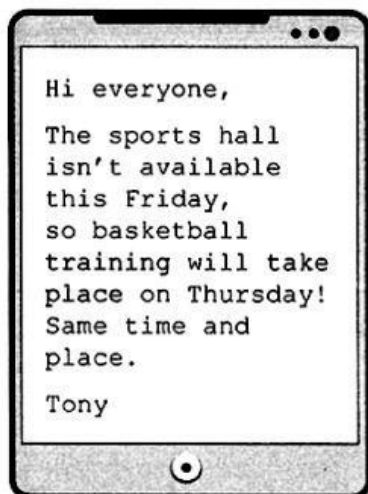
