Example: He **is working** in the garden.

Negative

I	+	am not	+	working	« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »
He					
She	+	is not	+	working	« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »
It		isn't			
You					
We	+	are not	+	working	« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »
You		aren't			
They					

Example: He **is not (isn't) working** in the garden.

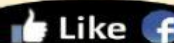

v (ing) *spelling rules*

Spelling Rules

1. Add **-ing** to most verbs
start - starting
jump - jumping
2. If the verb ends in **e**
cut **e** add **ing**
not for -ie or -ee
live - living
care - caring
3. If the verb ends in **ee**
add **ing**
see - seeing
agree - agreeing
4. If the verb ends in **ie**
cut **ie** add **y** then add **ing**
die - dying
tie - tying
5. One syllable verbs and ends
consonant + vowel + consonant
Double the last consonant and add **ing**
run - running
stop - stopping
6. **Do not** double if final letter is
w, x, y
play - playing
sew - sewing
mix - mixing

ADD -ES: when

1. The verbs ending in:

S : passes, kisses, misses, ...

Eg: She (pass) the mid-test.

X : fixes, mixes, relaxes, ...

Eg: The chef (mix) cake ingredients.

O : goes, does, echoes, ...

Eg: Tom (go) swimming once a week.

Z : quizzes, buzzes, ...

Eg: A mosquito (buzz) around me.

SH : washes, brushes, pushes, ...

Eg: He (brush) his teeth every day.

CH : watches, catches, teaches, ...

Eg: Cat (catch) mouse.

2. The verbs ending in:

Consonant + y → ~~y~~ → **ies**

fly → flies

Eg: The plane (fly) in the sky.

carry → carries

Eg: Mary (carry) lots of things.

deny → denies

Eg: My father (deny) the job here.

...

ADD -S: to the rest verbs

buy → buys

Eg: Her husband (buy) a gift for her.

take → takes

Eg: My parents (take) me to see doctor.

...

1 **E** = ~~E~~ + **ing**

dance → dancing

Eg: We (dance) at the party now.

leave → leaving

Eg: Candy (leave) home at present.

2 **EE** + **ing** = **EEing**

flee → fleeing

Eg: The prisoner (flee) away now.

see → seeing

Eg: He (see) someone.

3 **TE** = ~~TE~~ + **ing**

tie → tying

Eg: She (tie) the bow now.

lie → lying

Eg: That man (lie) to you.

4 **C1-V-C2*** = **double C2 + ing**

(*consonant-vowel-consonant)

run → running

Eg: Hurry up! The robber (run).

sew → sewing

Eg: My grandma (sew) now.
