Chilli peppers are one of the most popular spices worldwide, known for their spicy taste. The main ingredient in chillies is capsaicin. When people eat chillies, capsaicin interacts with temperature sensors in the body, creating a feeling of heat. This "hot" feeling is why chillies are often described as spicy.

Some studies suggest that eating chillies might help people live longer. A 2019 study in Italy found that people who ate chillies often had a lower risk of death compared to those who rarely ate them. Similarly, a 2015 study in China found that people who ate spicy foods daily had a 14% lower risk of death than those who ate them less often. Scientists believe this benefit may come from capsaicin, which can help lower cholesterol and reduce certain body **reactions** that may lead to illness.

However, eating too many chillies may not always be **favourable**. One study showed that eating large amounts of chillies was linked to weaker memory in older adults. While chillies may have some health benefits, their effects are still being studied. More research is needed to fully understand how chillies affect our health.
