- at the end of the month
- at the end of the film
- at the end of March
- at the end of the concert
- at the end of the game



in the end = finally

We use **in the end** when we say what the final result of a situation was:

We had a lot of problems with our car. We sold it **in the end**.
(= finally we sold it).

He got more and more angry. **In the end** he just walked out of the room.
