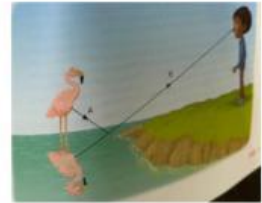

5. If the angle between the incident ray and normal is 30° . What will be the angle between normal and reflected ray?

6. If the angle between incident ray and the reflected ray is 50° . What will be the angle of incidence.?

7. If the angle between the reflecting surface and the normal is 20° . Find the angle of incidence.
