<b>Where</b> /wer/ Used to ask about a <b>place</b> or location. Example: Where is the book? — It's on the table.	<b>When</b> /wen/ Used to ask about <b>time</b> or moment something happens. Example: When is the party? — It's on Friday.	<b>What time</b> /wʌt taɪm/ Used to ask about the specific <b>hour</b> something happens. Example: What time is it? — It's 3 o'clock.	<b>Why</b> /wai/ Used to ask for a <b>reason</b> or explanation. Example: Why is he crying? — <b>Because</b> he's sad.	<b>What</b> /wʌt/ Used to ask for information about <b>something</b> . Example: What is that? — It's a toy.	<b>Who</b> /hu/ Used to ask about a <b>person</b> or people. Example: Who is he? — He is my teacher.	<b>How</b> /haʊ/ Used to ask about the way or <b>manner</b> something is done. Example: How do you go to school? — By bus.
