Used to ask for a **reason** or explanation.

Example: Why is he crying? — Because he's sad.

Used to ask for information about **something**.

Example: What is that? — It's a toy.

/hu/

Used to ask about a **person** or people.

Example: Who is he? — He is my teacher.



How
/hau/

Used to ask about the **way** or **manner** something is done.

Example: How do you go to school? — By bus.
