<p>- after some time, but not right now. It can be in an hour, tonight, or even tomorrow. Eg: "I will do my homework later." (= Not now, maybe in the evening.)</p>	<p>- very quickly or in a short time. It's closer to now than "later." Eg: "Let's go soon. The bus is coming!" (= We need to go in a minute or two.)</p>
