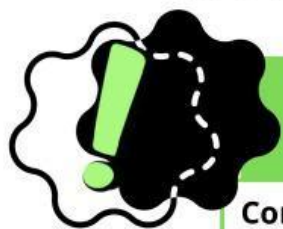

AFFIRMATIVE

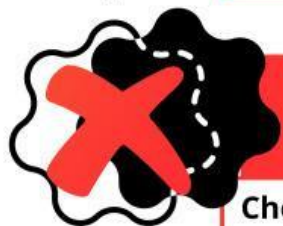

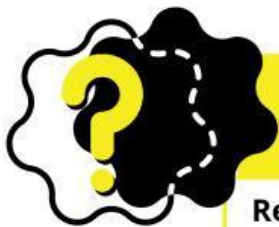

"GOING TO" USES!

Apart from expressing a DECISION or FUTURE PLANS, other use for "TO BE GOING TO" is to make PREDICTIONS when something in the present gives you an idea or EVIDENCE of what is going to happen or not going to happen in the future.
