The effects of social media

Does age affect how we experience the fear of missing out (FOMO) on social media? We asked student Jakub, 20, for his thoughts.

For me, FOMO is a funny thing. It means being jealous of what other people are doing because you've seen it on their social media. Some people think that others are having a lot of fun while they're sitting at home or feel jealous of their friends' new clothes or family holiday. This leads to feelings that their life is boring, or they have no friends or money.

I guess it's harder for teenagers who are still at school and might feel the need to check what friends are doing many times a day. They could think they are under pressure to respond to social media messages immediately. If they don't, they might miss out on what people are chatting about. They also want to seem fun – and joining in means other people don't get the chance to say anything bad about you.

When I was younger, I had a lot of online friends who checked their social media posts all the time. They always seemed to be having a brilliant time, but as I got older, I realized it might not be exactly true. Even if a party was boring, they came up with posts that looked as though they were enjoying themselves. It's pretty sad that people couldn't be honest about what their lives were really like.

Social media plays a real part in young people's lives, which older generations need to get. It's not all about FOMO: it's a way to socialize. My grandad fails to understand why younger people report every second of their lives for others to comment on. But he thinks it's cool that he can video-call me and message his friends online.

My mum, who's 47, uses social media but didn't grow up with digital devices. Because social media didn't really exist, she was used to communicating by phone. Although she and her friends sometimes update their status on social media, what people post doesn't affect her in a negative way. She doesn't get that letting people know what you're doing regularly is now a thing.

Parents and grandparents need to realize that most of the time young people are just enjoying sending each other videos and messages and staying connected. No one wants to be the last to know the latest news! But it's essential for them to talk to their kids (especially the younger ones) about social media so they can stay safe and have fun: that's what social media was really invented for.
