Europe is facing serious issues with the quality of its water. A recent report found that only about one-third of Europe's rivers, lakes, and other surface water are in good condition. In 2021, it was discovered that only 37% of Europe's surface water met good ecological standards, and 29% met good chemical standards. The results are far below the target the EU set for 2015, which was later extended to 2027. However, it now seems likely that Europe will miss this goal.

The report explains that pollution from farms and coal-fired power plants are major sources of water pollution. Farms use large amounts of water and release chemical pollutants into rivers and lakes. Power plants also produce toxic particles that harm water quality. Some areas in western and central Europe, including countries like Germany and the Netherlands, have a high number of polluted water bodies.

In addition to surface water, groundwater in Europe is also affected. However, the report found that Europe's groundwater is in **slightly better condition**, with 97% rated as having a good amount and 77% meeting good chemical standards.

Experts suggest several ways to improve water quality, including reducing water use, decreasing harmful pollutants, and restoring rivers and wetlands. Scientists warn that action is essential, especially as climate change leads to more extreme weather events, like floods. They believe that healthier water ecosystems can help reduce the impact of climate change on Europe.
