Social Media and Our Wellbeing

On a chilly morning in Charville, Queensland, Australia, 18-year-old Jordi begins her day by serving coffee to the town's early risers. While Charville is the place she calls home, Jordi views social media as an alternate world she also inhabits.

She currently spends about 5.5 hours daily online—less than the 7 to 8 hours she used to spend in high school, primarily on TikTok and Snapchat. The reduction came after personal growth and a painful experience with online bullying, when boys cruelly told her to end her life on TikTok. Despite such experiences, she found it hard to disconnect due to a constant fear of missing out. For Jordi, social media brings both joy and self-doubt, offering moments of happiness alongside feelings of insecurity.

Dr. Alisa Werner-Sidler, a researcher focused on the link between digital device use and adolescent mental health, believes that more in-depth studies and transparency from tech companies are crucial. While social platforms have built-in safety features, their effectiveness remains uncertain. Jordi appreciates her mother's role in helping her cut down her screen time. She even thinks a short-term shutdown of social media could be good for everyone.
