Globalization is causing a lot of change in international culture, from the TV shows we watch to the clothes we wear. One major area that has been affected by globalization is food culture. It seems clear that globalization has significantly affected food consumption in most parts of the world, but one country whose food has a long history of being “globalized” is Italy.

In Italy, changing trends have affected the preparation of food. Italian families have always taken a lot of pride in preparing food. Until recently, pasta - a basic Italian food - would have been made by people in their local area. People no longer spend so much time preparing their meals.
