

Use of "Can"

Can is used to talk about things that you are able to do (abilities). It means "poder"

- Paolo Guerrero can play soccer. (Paolo Guerrero puede jugar futbol.)
- Natalia Malaga can play volleyball. (Natalia Malaga puede jugar voley)

- They **can** do karate.

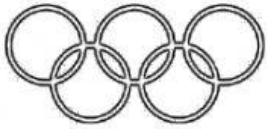
