In the UK, many drivers are choosing to keep their older cars instead of buying new ones. **Currently**, 16 million out of 34 million cars on British roads are over ten years old. This trend is expected to continue as people choose to maintain their existing vehicles rather than purchase new ones.

Several factors contribute to this preference for older cars. The rising cost of new vehicles makes them less accessible for many individuals. Additionally, higher taxes on new car purchases discourage people from upgrading. Concerns about the shift towards electric vehicles (EVs) also play a role; some drivers prefer to stick with familiar petrol or diesel cars.

The average age of cars in the UK has increased significantly, from 6.6 years in 2003 to 9.4 years today. This means more older cars are on the road, which can have an impact on environmental goals, as newer models typically produce fewer emissions. Older cars may experience mechanical problems over time, leading to higher maintenance costs for their owners.

Experts suggest that to encourage drivers to adopt newer, cleaner vehicles, there should be more **rewards** and support. This could include making new cars more affordable and improving the infrastructure for electric vehicles. Without such measures, the trend of keeping older cars is likely to continue.
