## Contractions with question words

You can ask questions with *What's*, *Where's*, *When's*, and *How's*.

*What's her name?* (= *What is her name?*)

*Where's he from?* (= *Where is he from?*)

*How's your mother?* (= *How is your mother?*)

Don't contract *is* in a question when the last word is a pronoun (*he*, *she*, *it*, etc.).

*How old is she?* NOT *How old's she?*

*Where is he?* NOT *Where's he?*

*What is it?* NOT *What's it?*
