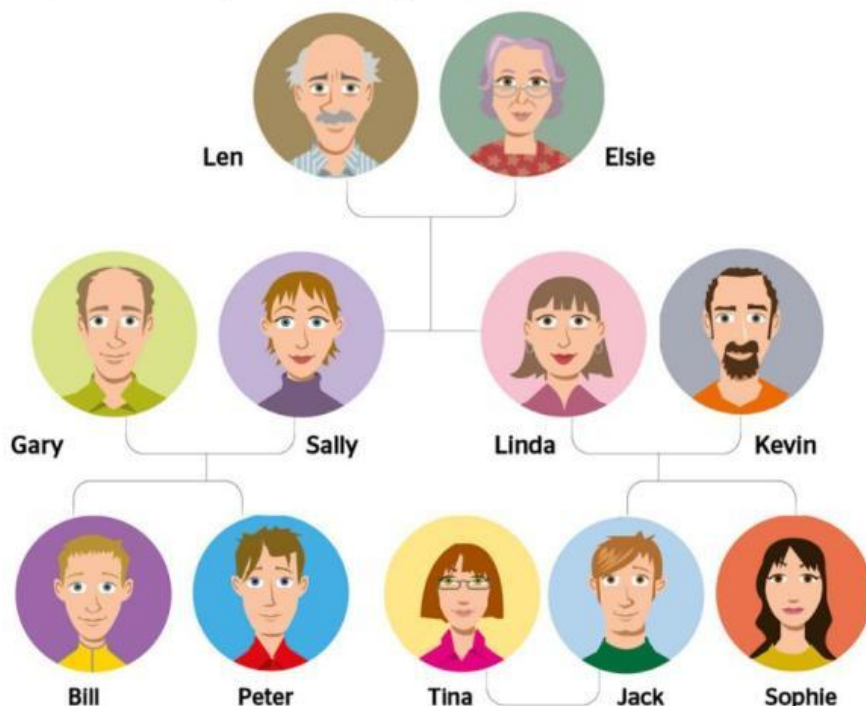

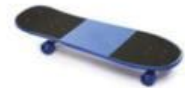

Some nouns have the same form in both singular and plural, especially animals.

Examples:

- fish → fish
- deer → deer
- sheep → sheep
