Final Cut King

From the age of 7, Zach King liked making videos using his dad's video camera. He bought his own camera as well as a computer when he was 14 and he started making and editing¹ videos.

Zach started his own website in 2008 and he also had a YouTube channel. He wanted to teach people how to edit videos because there were no videos showing people how to do this online. He sold these videos and he used the money to pay for university. While he was at university, he made a funny video called *Jedi Kittens* with a friend and posted it on YouTube. 18 million people watched it. Then, he made a second video called *Jedi Kittens Strike Back* and 27 million people watched it. Zach finished his studies in Cinema and Media Arts in 2012. In 2021, he had 11.2 million fans on YouTube.

In 2013, Zach started making six-second videos. They were very popular and people started calling him 'Final Cut King'. That's because he did an amazing job with editing videos. In 2014, he appeared on TV shows and he became more popular. He started posting on TikTok in 2016 and by 2021 he had over 66.3 million fans. He made a special TikTok video in December 2019. In the video, he looks like he's flying a broomstick like Harry Potter, and more than 2 billion people watched it. Actually, no other TikTok video has had so many views² up until now.

Today, he has over 77 million fans and his videos have 1 billion likes. He is sixth in the top ten people on TikTok. He says he likes "bringing a little more wonder into the world, 15 seconds at a time."
