The Bali Starling (*Leucopsar rothschildi*), also known as the Jalak Bali, is a rare bird native to the island of Bali, Indonesia. It is recognized for its striking white feathers, blue skin around the eyes, and a wispy crest. The Bali Starling is the only bird species endemic to Bali and is considered the island's official fauna symbol.
