Tour de France

The *Tour de France* is a bicycle race which takes place every year for twenty-three days in July and August. (1) ... There are sometimes sections of the race which go across the borders.

The winner is the cyclist who completes the course the most quickly over the twenty-three days. (2) ... This isn't the only prize. For example, the cyclist who is the fastest in the mountain sections is called the 'King of the Mountains'. There is also a prize for the best young rider.
