## Listening Through Song for 11th Grade Students



## Learning Objectives:

1. Students will be able to memorize vocabulary from the song.
2. Students will be able to identify simple present tense in the lyrics.
3. Students will be able to identify synonyms of key vocabulary from the lyrics

### Task 1

to do, oh yeah.


If you're tossin' and you're turnin' and

## Hint:

The **Simple Present Tense** is used to talk about:

- Habits (things we do regularly)
- General truths or facts
- Feelings or states

How to use it:

1. Use the base form of the verb (Verb 1):  
smile, know, light up
2. Add -s/-es if the subject is singular (he, she, it)
3. For negatives: use don't/doesn't
