NATURE IN THE BIG CITY

When we think of huge cities like New York or London, nature is not the first thing that comes to mind. However, if you make the effort to look for it, you discover that nature in a city area is nothing unusual. For example, I used to think that real nature could be found only outside cities.

7.2. ____ This small green space along the banks of the River Thames had been set up by volunteers, and it featured labelled plants, information maps, and pictures of the riverside birds. Schoolchildren were brought there to discover the bits of nature that still survived in their city, and it was an amazing experience.

While that little piece of nature has since been built over, some larger, more organised projects are being developed in cities. One of the most recent and impressive of these is the Walthamstow Wetlands in North London. **7.3.** ____ And because of its size, as you walk along its trails you can forget that the city centre is only a short trip away.
