1. It is very hot during the day and cold at night. It rains very little. Animals like camels and lizards live here. Plants like cacti and small bushes grow in the sand.

2. It is very cold and dry. There is snow on the ground for many months. Polar bears, reindeer, and arctic foxes live here. Only moss and lichen grow low on the ground.

3. This place is flat and dry. It is hot in summer and cold in winter. Lions, zebras, and bison live here. You can see tall grass and wildflowers.

4. It is hot and wet all year. It rains a lot. There are monkeys, snakes, and birds with bright colors. Big trees, vines, and green plants grow everywhere.

5. This place has four seasons. It is warm in summer and cold in winter. Deer, bears, and foxes live here. Trees lose their leaves in autumn.

6. It is warm and in the sea. The water is not deep. Many colorful fish and sea turtles swim here. Coral and seaweed grow under the water.
