**Iga Świątek –
Polish talent**



Iga Świątek made history in 2020 when she won the French Open tennis tournament. Not only was she the first ever Polish tennis player to win a Grand Slam singles tournament, she was also the lowest ranked winner of the women's French Open since rankings were introduced. At the start of the tournament, she was fifty-fourth in the world.

One important member of Iga's team is her sports psychologist. As a young player, Iga had a few problems controlling her emotions, especially when making a mistake, which led to her dropping points and even losing matches. As many sports stars have found out, there is a tiny difference between victory and defeat, and being in the right frame of mind while playing is vital. A sports psychologist can help a player go into a match with a positive attitude. The psychologist even gave Iga a ukulele at one point, as the instrument is said to help people control their emotions more easily.

Music is very important to Iga, and she loves old rock music. Her taste in music comes not from her family or friends but her coaches. She heard the music they were listening to and found that it appealed to her. But although her father might not have influenced her musical tastes, he certainly had an influence on her life.
