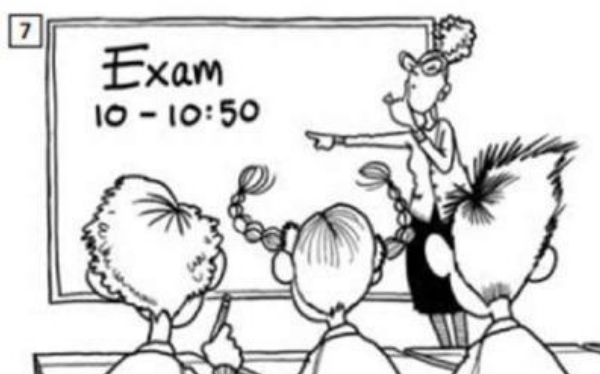
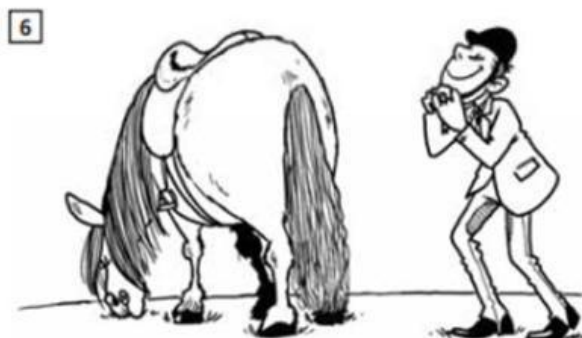

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Not everyone has 20/20 vision or perfect eyesight, but we can use glass and plastic lenses to help us see better. People have known about lenses for a long time. In fact, Egyptian hieroglyphs from the ¹_____ BC show lenses, but we don't know how the Egyptians used them. But we do know that the Emperor Nero used an emerald to help him see gladiators fight between ²_____ -68 AD.

Experts think people started wearing glasses around ³_____ in Italy. People wore them for short sight (when you can't see things far away) and for ageing sight, but they didn't know why they worked. Centuries later, in the ⁴_____, Johannes Kepler found out that artificial lenses corrected the way human lenses focus light on the retina.

Leonardo Da Vinci designed contact lenses in the ⁵_____. But no one made them. Three hundred years later, eye specialists tried to make contact lenses in the ⁶_____ but they were too heavy to wear. The first light lenses appeared in the ⁷_____. However, they were expensive and broke easily. They also stopped oxygen getting to the eye.
