With the help of Aslan, a talking lion and the most powerful creature in the land, they win the fight against the witch and her evil creatures. Spring returns to Narnia, and it is a happy place again. Unfortunately, the Pevensies have to return to the "real" world and leave their new friends behind. But all four agree that discovering Narnia is the most amazing experience of their lives.
