**Reported Questions**

direct question	reported question
She said: "Are you cold?"	She asked me if I was cold.
He said: "Where's my pen?"	He asked where his pen was.

Reported questions are one form of reported speech.

We usually introduce reported questions with the verb "ask":

- He asked (me) if/whether... (YES/NO questions)
- He asked (me) why/when/where/what/how... (Question Word questions)
