Negative	I/You/We/ They/He/ She/It	won't (= will not)	forget to call. charge for Wi-Fi access. miss the deadline.

Promises and agreements

We also use *will* / *won't* to make promises and to agree to do (or not do) something.

Thanks for the invitation. I will (I'll) confirm on Friday.

I will not (won't) forget to send the list.

Decisions

We use *will* / *won't* to make decisions at the moment of speaking.

A: What time is lunch?

B: I'll check the break times.

My flight is cancelled. I'll stay in a hotel tonight. I won't go home.

Offers

We also use *will* to make offers.

A: I can't use this computer.

B: I'll try and fix it for you.

A: I'm really busy. I don't have time for lunch.

B: Don't worry, I'll get something from the canteen for us.


